# HATS, SOCKS & WRIST WARMERS

## KNITTED IN KING COLE ZIG ZAG

### TENSION

28sts and 36 rows to 10cm, 4in over stocking stitch using **3.25mm knitting needles** or the size required to give correct tension. If there are less sts to 10cm, 4in, than number stated, change to a finer needle. If there are more sts to 10cm, 4in, than number stated, change to a larger needle. It is essential to work to the tension stated.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**beg** beginning, **cm** centimetres, **cont** continue, **in** inch(es), **K** knit, **mm** millimetres, **P** purl, **psso** pass slipped stitch over, **rep** repeat, **rem** remain(ing), **sts** stitches **s1** slip one stitch knitways, **s1p** slip stitch purlwise, **tog** together, **yfwd** yarn forward

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**1x1 Rib.**

**1st Row:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd Row:** P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows.

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### HAT

Using **2.75mm needles** cast on 145sts and work 8 rows in 1x1 rib.

**Change to 3.25mm needles** and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row:** P1, \*K5, P1, rep from \* to end.

**2nd Row:** \*K1, P5, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**3rd Row:** P1, \*K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, P1, rep from \* to end.

**4th Row:** \*K1, P5, rep from \* to last st, K1.

1st to 4th row set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set cont until Hat measures approximately 18cm, ending with 2nd row of patt.

#### Shape Crown.

**1st Row:** P1, \*K1, s1, K2tog, psso, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. 97sts.

**2nd Row:** \*K1, P3, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**3rd Row:** P1, \*s1, K2tog, psso, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1. 49sts.

**4th Row:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**5th Row:** P1, (K2tog) 24 times. 25sts.

**6th Row:** (P2tog) 12 times, K1. 13sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

### TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

### SOCKS

#### LEG

Using **3.25mm needles** cast on 44 [52:56]sts onto one needle.

Divide sts fairly equally between 3 needles in multiples of 4.

Working in K2, P2 rib, work in rounds until Leg measures 8cm, from beg.

Knit every round until Leg measures 15 [17.5: 20.5]cm from beg, or desired length to top of heel.

Count the rounds worked to this point to ensure that both socks will be alike.

#### HEEL

Working in rows cont as follows:

**1st Row:** K11 [13:14], turn work and with same needle, P22 [26:28].

Place remaining 22 [26:28]sts equally onto the 2 spare needles.

**2nd Row** (Right side): \* With yarn at back s1p, K1, rep from \* to end.

**3rd Row:** With yarn in front s1p, P to end.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 10 [12:13] times more.

#### Turn Heel.

**1st Row** (Right side): K13 [15:16], s1, K1, psso, K1, turn.

**2nd Row:** S1P, P5, P2tog, P1, turn.

**3rd Row:** S1P, K to 1 st before gap made on 2nd row, s1, K1, psso (1 st from each side of gap), K1, turn.

**4th Row:** S1P, P to 1 st before gap made on 3rd row, P2tog, P1, turn.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until all heel sts have been worked, ending with a wrong side row. 14 [16:16]sts.

### GUSSET

#### Round 1

**Needle 1:** K across 14 [16:16] Heel sts, then pick up and K12 [14:15]sts evenly down side edge of Heel making sure to pick up last st into corner to avoid a hole.

**Needle 2:** K22 [26:28]sts from spare needles.

**Needle 3:** Pick up and K12 [14:15]sts evenly up side edge of Heel, then K first 7 [8:8]sts from needle 1. (19 [22:23]sts each on needles 1 and 3 and 22 [26:28]sts on needle 2 for instep). 60 [70:74]sts in total.

Rounds now begin at centre back Heel.

#### Round 2

**Needle 1:** K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1.

**Needle 2:** Knit.

**Needle 3:** K1, s1, K1, psso, K to end.

#### Round 3:

Knit. Rep rounds 2 and 3 until 44 [52:56]sts rem.

11 [13:14]sts each on needles 1 and 3 and 22 [26:28]sts on needle 2.

Place a **marker** at this point to enable you to count the rounds worked for foot from this point.

### FOOT

Work every round knit until Foot measures 14 [16.5:19]cm from back of heel or 4 [4.5:5]cm shorter than length of foot required.

Count the rounds worked from **marker** to this point to ensure that both socks will be alike.

#### Toe.

#### Round 1:

**Needle 1:** Knit to last 3sts, K2tog, K1.

**Needle 2:** K1, s1, K1, psso, K to last 3sts,

K2tog, K1.

**Needle 3:** K1, s1, K1, psso, K to end.

#### Round 2:

Knit.

Rep rounds 1 and 2 until 20 [24:28]sts rem,

then rep round 1 only until 8sts rem.

Knit sts from needle 1 onto needle 3.

4sts each on 2 needles.

Slip sts from each needle onto 2 separate

threads.

Turn sock inside out.

Place sts back onto 2 needles and graft together by knitting together 1 st from each needle and casting off.

### WRIST WARMERS (Both Alike)

Using **2.75mm needles** cast on 55 [67]sts and work 12 rows in 1x1 rib.

**Change to 3.25mm needles** and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row:** P1, \*K5, P1, rep from \* to end.

**2nd Row:** \*K1, P5, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**3rd Row:** P1, \*K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, P1, rep from \* to end.

**4th Row:** \*K1, P5, rep from \* to last st, K1.

1st to 4th row set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set cont until Wrist Warmer measures approximately 18 [20]cm, ending with 4th row of patt.

**Change to 2.75mm needles** and commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 20 rows.

Cast off in rib

### TO MAKE UP

Join side seam, leaving opening for thumb within last 20 rows of rib, if required. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

<b>SOCKS</b>		1 Pair of 2.75mm (UK12 - US2) Knitting Needles for Hat and Wrist Warmers.	
Small	Medium	One set of 4 Double pointed needles size 3.25mm for Socks.	
<b>WRIST WARMERS</b>		<b>NOTES</b>	
Small/Medium	Medium/Large	The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, times or rows are worked for this size. After casting off one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow. Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.
