

WINTER WRIST WARMERS



TENSION

10x10cm square is 22sts by 28rows on 4mm/US6 needles

ABBREVIATIONS

approx approximately, **gt-st** garter stitch, **k** knit, **k2** knit two, **p** purl, **p2** purl two, **sl** slip stitch, **sts** stitches, **st-st** stocking stitch

MAKE TWO

Wrist warmer worked in a rectangle from the fingers to the wrist, then sewn up after.

Cast on 50 sts using thumb method.

Row 1: Sl1, K to end

Row 2: Sl1, K to end

These two rows set gt-st. Continue for 8 more rows.

Change to 4mm needles

Row 1: Sl1, K to end

Row 2: Sl1, P to end.

These two rows set st-st. Continue until work measures approx 10cm.

Change to 3.25mm needles

Row 1: K2, P2 to last two sts, K2.

Row 2: P2, K2 to last two sts, P2.

These two rows set rib. Continue in rib for two more rows.

Change to 4mm needles and continue in rib for 26 rows more.

Cast off in rib.

Fold in half matching up the rib to the rib and the gt-st to the gt-st. Sew a 4cm seam from cast on edge. Leave a 5cm gap for the thumb. Sew up remaining seam.

King Cole Majestic DK
2 x balls shade 3491 Brick

NEEDLES

3.25mm/US3
4mm/US6

Sewing up needle
