

# Textured Hat & Mitts



## TEXTURED HAT

Using 3¾ mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 93[99:105:107] sts.

Work as follows:

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to end.

**4th row:** \* P1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Last 2 rows are called 1x1 rib.

Work 7[7:9:9] rows more in 1x1 rib.

Next row. Purl to end, dec 4 sts evenly across row. 89[95:101:103] sts.

Break off M, join in C1.

Change to 4½ mm needles and work as follows:

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** S1, purl to end.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** S1, \* k1B, p1, rep from \* to end.



## TENSION

19 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm, 4 in over pattern on 4½ mm needles

## NEEDLES

Continued...

One pair 3¼ mm US 3

One pair of 4½mm US 7

## MEASUREMENTS

4-6 years, 7-9 years, 10-12 years, adult

## YARN

Luxury Merino DK

M = 2 x 50g ball 2625 Mildew

C1 = 2 x 50g ball 2610 White

C2 = 2 x 50g ball 2618 Sage



Change to C2.

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** S1, purl to end.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** S1, \* k1B, p1, rep from \* to end.

These 8 rows form colour and patt rep. Work until hat measures approximately

17[18:18:19] cm, 6½[7:7½] in, ending with 1st row of patt in C2.

Next row: S1, purl to end, inc

0[2:4:2] sts evenly across row.

89[97:105:105] sts.

Continuing in C2 only:

### Shape Crown

**1st row:** Patt 1, (patt3tog, patt 5)

11[12:13:13] times. 67[73:79:79] sts.

Work 3 rows more in patt.

**5th row:** Patt 1, (patt3tog, patt 3)

11[12:13:13] times. 45[49:53:53] sts.

Work 3 rows more in patt.

**9th row:** Patt 1, (patt3tog, patt 1)

11[12:13:13] times. 23[25:27:27] sts.

Work 3 rows more in patt.

**13th row:** Patt 1, (patt2tog)

11[12:13:13] times. 12[13:14:14] sts.

**14th row:** (P2tog) 6[6:7:7] times,

p0[1:0:0]. 6[7:7:7] sts.

### TO MAKE UP

Join seam.

Having completed both the hats and mitts, use remainder of yarn to make the pompom. Make pompom 8cm in diameter and affix to top of hat. Cover with a clean damp, tea towel and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

### TEXTURED MITTS

(Both alike)

Using 3¾ mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 31[33:35:37] sts.

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to end.

**4th row:** \* P1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Last 2 rows are called 1x1 rib.

Work 9 rows more in 1x1 rib.

**14th row.** Purl to end dec 2 sts evenly across row. 29[31:33:35] sts. Break off M, join in C1.

Change to 4½ mm needles and work as follows:

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** S1, purl to end.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** S1, \* k1B, p1, rep from \*

to end.

Change to C2.

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** S1, purl to end.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** S1, \* k1B, p1, rep from \* to end.

These 8 rows form colour and patt rep. Work until hat measures approximately

12.5[14.5:16.5:18.5] cm,

5[5¾:6½:7¼] in, ending with 1st row of patt in C2.

**Next row:** S1, purl to end, inc 2 sts evenly across row. 31[33:35:37] sts.

Continuing in C2 only:

Change 3¾ mm needles and beg with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 4 rows. Cast off in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join seam leaving 4[4:5:5] cm, 1½[1½:2:2] in, opening for thumb, 4 cm, 1½ in, down from cast-off edge. Cover with a clean damp, tea towel and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## TENSION

It is very important to check your tension before commencing the items, therefore crochet or knit a tension square. If there are less sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a smaller hook or needle. If there are more sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a larger hook or needle. It is important to work to the tension stated.

## NOTES

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Most of these projects will not use all of one ball, therefore, it will be possible to make more than one item from a ball of yarn.
