

Knitted Angel

This gorgeous angel can be used to top a tree, adorn a festive table, or gifted to little ones.

BODY

Back and Front (Alike)

With A cast on 16sts.

1st Row: K15, turn.

2nd Row: Sl 1, K13, turn.

3rd Row: Sl 1, K11, turn.

4th Row: Sl 1, K9, turn.

5th Row: Sl 1, K to end across all sts.

6th Row: Knit.

Work 5 rows in gst.

Next Row: K1, K2tog, K10, K2tog, K1.

Work 3 rows in gst.

Next Row: K1, K2tog, K8, K2tog, K1. 12sts.

Cont in gst dec 1 st at each end of every foll 4th row in this way until 6sts rem.

Work 3 rows in gst.

Next Row: (K2tog) 3 times. 3sts.
Sl sts onto a thread.

When both pieces have been worked sl all 6sts sts onto same thread, draw up and secure.

ARMS (In one piece)

With A cast on 6sts.

Work 32 rows in gst.

Cast off.

HANDS (Make 2)

With B cast on 2sts and K 1 row.

Next Row: Knit, inc in each st. 4sts.
Work 5 rows in gst.
Cast off.

HEAD

With B cast on 4sts and K 1 row.

Work 3 rows in gst inc 1 st at each end of every row. 10sts.
Work 6 rows in gst.
Work 3 rows in gst dec 1 st at each end of every row. 4sts.
K 1 row.
Cast off.

HAIR

With D cast on 18sts and K 2 rows.
Cast off 4sts at beg of next 2 rows. 10sts.
Work 3 rows in gst dec 1 st at each end of every row. 4sts.
K 1 row.
Cast off.

WINGS – Using yarn double (make 2)

With C cast on 3sts and K 1 row.

Next Row: Inc in first 2sts, K1. 5sts
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Inc in first st, K2, inc in next st, K1. 7sts
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Inc in first st, K4, inc in next st, K1. 9sts
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Inc in first st, K to end. 10sts
K 2 rows.
Next Row: K1, K2tog, K to last 3sts, K2tog, k1. 8sts
Next Row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows twice more. 4sts
Next Row: K1, K2tog, K1. 3sts
Next Row: Sl 1, K2tog, psso and fasten off.

MAKE UP

Sew up side edges of arms to form a long tube. Tuck cast on edge of each hand into open ends of tube and sew in place. Sew up side seams of body leaving top 6 rows open. Sew cast on edges together and stuff lightly. Slot Arms through Body at top and sew up cast off edge. Sew Hands together. Run a thread around outer edge of head and draw up. Insert a small amount of stuffing. Sew Head to Body placing drawn up edge of head to back. Run a thread round the back of hair (leaving the long pieces loose) and shape to head. Sew Hair to Head. Tie a piece of thread around long pieces to form bunches. Sew cast on edges of wings together, reversing one wing so that shapings mirror each other. Sew Wings to Body.

TENSION

14sts and 26 rows to 10cm (4in) over st-st on 3¾mm needles using DK yarn.

MEASUREMENTS AND SIZES

Actual size (approximately)
16 cm, 6"
From head to toe 4 ins

OTHER MATERIALS

Washable Toy Stuffing.

NEEDLES

5.5mm (US9, UK5)

YARN

King Cole
Big Value Chunky – 100g Balls
A = White 822
B = Blush 3488
C = Yellow 828
D = Spice 3282

TENSION

It is very important to check your tension before commencing the items, therefore crochet or knit a tension square. If there are less sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a smaller hook or needle. If there are more sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a larger hook or needle. It is important to work to the tension stated.

NOTES

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Most of these projects will not use all of one ball, therefore, it will be possible to make more than one item from a ball of yarn.
