

# Teddy

## SIDES (Make 2)

### First Leg

Using 3¾ mm needles, M and thumb method cast on 5 sts.

**1st row:** K5.

**2nd row:** Inc in first st, p3, inc in last st. 7 sts.

Join in C.

**3rd row:** Using C inc in first st, k5, inc in last st. 9 sts.

**4th row:** Using C purl.

**5th row:** Using M knit.

**6th row:** Using M purl.

**7th row:** Using C knit.

**8th row:** Using C purl.

**9th to 12th rows:** As 5th to 8th rows. \*\*

Break yarn and leave these 9 sts on a holder.

### Second Leg

Work as given for First Leg to \*\*.



## TENSION

23 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 3¾ mm needles

## MEASUREMENTS

21 cm / 8¼ in

## NEEDLES

1 pair 3¾ mm US 5

Oddments of contrast yarn for face

Washable toy filling

## YARN

Big Value DK DK

M = 1 x 50g ball 4021 Cream

C = 1 x 50g ball 4029 Red

Continued...



### Join Legs

**13th row:** Using M k across 9 sts of Second Leg, turn and cast on 4 sts, turn and k across 9 sts of First Leg. 22 sts.

**14th row:** Using M purl.

**15th row:** Using C knit.

**16th row:** Using C purl.

**17th row:** Using M knit.

**18th row:** Using M purl.

**19th to 34th rows:** As 15th to 18th rows 4 times.

Break off C and cont using M only.

### Shape Arms

**35th row:** Cast on and k 7 sts, k to end. 29 sts.

**36th row:** Cast on and p 7 sts, p to last st, inc in last st. 37 sts.

**37th row:** Inc in fi rst st, k to last st, inc in last st. 39 sts.

**38th row:** Inc in first st, p to end. 40 sts.

**39th row:** Knit.

**40th row:** Purl.

**41st and 42nd rows:** As 39th and 40th rows.

**43rd row:** K2tog, k to end. 39 sts.

**44th row:** P2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2tog. 37 sts.

**45th row:** Cast off 12 sts, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. 24 sts.

**46th row:** Cast off 12 sts, p to end. 12 sts.

### Shape Head

**47th row:** Inc in fi rst st, k to last st, inc in last st. 14 sts.

**48th row:** Inc in fi rst st, p to last st, inc in last st. 16 sts.

**49th row:** As 47th row. 18 sts.

**50th row:** Purl.

**51st row:** Knit.

**52nd to 61st rows:** As 50th and 51st rows 5 times.

### Shape Ears

**62nd row:** Inc in fi rst st, p to last st, inc in last st. 20 sts.

**63rd row:** Inc in fi rst st, k to last st, inc in last st. 22 sts.

**64th row:** Purl.

**65th row:** Knit.

**66th row:** Purl.

**67th row:** K5 and turn.

Work on this set of 5 sts only for top of first ear as follows:

**68th row:** P2tog, p1, p2tog. 3 sts.

**69th row:** Slip 1 st, k2tog, pass slipped st over and fasten off.

Return to rem 17 sts on needles, rejoin M with rs facing and cont as follows:

**67th row:** Cast off 12 sts, k to end. 5 sts.

**68th row:** P2tog, p1, p2tog. 3 sts.

**69th row:** Slip 1 st, k2tog, pass slipped st over and fasten off.

### TO MAKE UP

Sew Sides together around entire outer edge, leaving an opening along one side edge. Insert toy filling so Teddy is fairly firmly filled, then sew opening closed. Run a gathering thread around neck and pull up quite tightly to define head section, then fasten off securely. Stitch through all layers across base of ears to define ears.

## TENSION

It is very important to check your tension before commencing the items, therefore crochet or knit a tension square. If there are less sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a smaller hook or needle. If there are more sts to 10cm (4in) than number stated, change to a larger hook or needle. It is important to work to the tension stated.

## NOTES

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Most of these projects will not use all of one ball, therefore, it will be possible to make more than one item from a ball of yarn.
