## Ceiling Rose (make 4)


#### Abstract

Let's take a moment to look inside the room. Maybe it's plain and simple, maybe it's colorful, maybe its ultra-modern or maybe it's filled with traditional décor. A bedroom, a living room, or even a kitchen. Here we have some decorative squares like a ceiling rose in an old hotel room, a vase of flowers in a corner, floral wallpaper or even a stained-glass window!


Using Yarn E, make 4ch, sl st to first ch to join into a ring (or make a magic circle).

Round 1 (RS) 3ch (does not count as $s t$ ), 12 dc into the ring, sl st to first de to join. [12 sts]

Round 2 3ch (now counts as first dc here and throughout), 1 dc into same st at base of $3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st and each st to end, sl st to top of first 3 ch, fasten off (do not cut yarn, this can be re-joined in Round 4). [24 sts]

Round 3 Join Yarn C into any st, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in same st, 1 dc in next st, ( $2 d \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in next st) to end, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [36 sts]

Round 4 Re-join Yarn E around the stem of any st inserting hook from right to left going from the back to the front and then round to the back again, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ BPdc around same st, 1BPdc around each of next 2 sts, (2BPdc around next st, 1BPdc around each of next 2 sts) to end, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [48 sts]

Round 5 Join Ecru/Cream into any st, 1ch (does not count as st), 1 sc in same st, 1 sc in each of next 3 sts, skip next 2 sts instead working (1 FPdtr, 2ch, 1FPdtr) around the dc directly below them 3 rounds below in Round 2, * 1 sc in each of next 4
sts, skip next 2 sts instead working (1 FPdtr, 2ch, 1 FPdtr) around the third double crochet along from previous dc worked around in
Round 2 (leave 2 sts in-between the raised sts in Round 2), repeat from * six times, sl st to first sc, fasten off. [8 groups of raised sts and 2-ch-sps with 4 sc in-between]

Round 6 Join Yarn C into any 2 -ch-sp, 3ch, 8 dc in same place, 1 ch, skip 6 sts, ( 9 dc in next 2 -chsp, 1 ch, skip 6 sts) to end, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [ 8 shells of 9 dc plus 1 -ch-sp in-between]

Round 7 Join Yarn E into 1-ch-sp in-between any 2 groups of 9 dc , $3 \mathrm{ch}, 7 \mathrm{dc}$ in same place, *skip next 9 sts instead working into 2 skipped sts in same color below in Round 4 with $1 d c$ in first st, 2ch, 1 dc in next st (work behind the shell in Round 6) ${ }^{* *}$, 8 dc in 1 -ch-sp before next group of 9 dc , repeat from * seven times ending final repeat at **, sl st to top of first 3 ch, fasten off. [8 shells of 8 dc plus 8 groups of 2 dc with 2-ch-sp in-between]

Round 8 Join Black into any 2-chsp in-between the $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch},(3 \mathrm{dc}$, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same place, 1 ch, * skip 10 sts, ( $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next 2-ch-sp, 1 ch, repeat from * six times, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [8 groups of 8 dc plus 2 ch with 1 -ch-sp in-between]

Round 9 Join Yarn G into any 1 -ch-sp in-between the groups of dc (not the 2-ch-sp in-between the 4 dc$), 3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in same place, * 1 dc in each of next 2 sts (pay attention to crochet into the first st which is less clear to see), 1hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 2 ch, skip 2-ch-sp, 1 sc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 2 sts **, 3 dc in next 1 -ch-sp, repeat from * seven times ending final repeat at **, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [88 sts plus $8 \times 2$-ch-sps]

Round 10 Join Yarn J into any 2-ch-sp in Round 8 (ensure hook also goes under the 2 ch from Round 9 to encase it and neaten - do this at each 2-ch-sp in this round), 4ch (counts as 1 dc and 1 $\mathrm{ch}), 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in same place, 1 dc in each of next 11 sts, *(1dc, 1ch, 1 dc ) in next 2-ch-sp in Round 8, 1 dc in each of next 11 sts, repeat from * six times, sl st to 3rd ch of beginning 4 ch, fasten off. [104 sts pls $8 \times$ 1 -ch-sps]

A square will now be created around the octagon. The next round is made working into the back loops only as indicated.

Round 11 (RS) Join Yarn D into any 1 -ch-sp, 6 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch$), 1$ tr in same place, * 1 tr in blo of each of next 3 sts, 1 dc in blo of each of next 3 sts, 1hdc in blo of each of next 3 sts, 1 sc in
blo of each of next 4 sts, skip 1 ch and the 1 -ch-sp, 1 sc in blo of each of next 4 sts, 1 hdc in blo of each of next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in blo of each of next 3 sts, 1 tr in blo of each of next 3 sts**, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in next 1 -chsp, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, sl st to 4th ch of beginning 6 ch, do not fasten off, turn. [28 sts on each side plus 4 corner 2-ch-sps]

The next round is made with the WS facing.

Round 12 (WS) 4ch (counts as first tr), 1 tr in next st, * 1 dc in each of next 3 sts, 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts, 1 sc in each of next 10 sts , 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts, 1 tr in each of next 2 sts, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in next corner ch-sp**, 1 tr in each of next 2 sts, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, sl st to top of first 4 ch, fasten off, turn. [ 30 sts on each side plus 4 corner 2 -ch-sps]

Round 13 (RS) Join Yarn F into any corner ch-sp, 5ch (counts as 1 dc and 2 ch$), 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in same corner ch-sp, * 1 dc in each st to end of side, ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner chsp , repeat from * two times, 1 dc in each st to end of side, sl st to 3rd ch of beginning 5 ch , fasten off. [32 sts on each side plus 4 corner 2-chsps]

Round 14 (RS) Join Black into any corner ch-sp, 1 ch (does not count as st), * ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in corner chsp, 1 sc in each of next 14 sts, skip next st instead working 1 FPquadtr around the dc to the right of the 2-ch-sp in black below in Round 8,1 sc in each of next 2 sts, skip next st instead working 1 FPquadtr around the dc to the left of the 2-chsp below in Round 8, 1 sc in each of next 14 sts, repeat from * three times, sl st to first sc, turn. [34 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2 -ch-sps]

The next round is made with the WS facing. For 'Lights Off' continue in Black. For 'Lights On' change to Ecru/Cream at end of Round 14 and use Ecru/Cream for Rounds $15-16$.

Round 15 (WS) 2ch (counts as first hdc), * 1hdc in next st and each st to end of side, ( 1 hdc, 2ch 1hdc) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * three times, sl st to top of first 2 ch , turn. [ 36 sts on each side with $4 \times$ corner 2-ch-sps]

The next round is made with the RS facing.

Round 16 (RS) 3ch, 1 dc in next st, * (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in corner ch-sp, 1 dc in each st to end of side (pay attention to crochet into the final hdc st of the side which is less clear to see), repeat from * three times, sl st to top of first 3 ch , fasten off. [40 sts on each side with $4 \times$ corner 1 -ch-sps]


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
