AUTUMN PUMPKINS

Small, Medium & Large





Pictured yarn used: Big Value Chunky 'Mustard'

Materials Required:

- 1 6mm Crochet Hook
- 1 Ball Big Value Chunky Moss
- Toy filler
- Sewing up needle
- 1 Ball Main body shade chosen from recommended selection below:
(Quantity needed for Small Pumpkin: 20g, Medium Pumpkin: 60g, Large Pumpkin: 100g)

Sustainable tip:
Save your yarn scraps
and use them for toy
filling!

Big Value Chunky:



3282 Spice



3486 Turmeric



3312 Mustard



1746 Mango



3491 Burnt Orange

Riot Chunky:



3880 Woodland



3080 Hazelnut

Abbreviations:

- BLO** Back Loop Only
- Ch** Chain
- DC** Double Crochet
- St** Stitches
- Slst** Slip Stitch

Measurements:

Small Pumpkin:

Approx 3 in x 4 in (8x10cm)

Medium Pumpkin:

Approx 4 in x 6in (10x15cm)

Large Pumpkin:

Approx 6in x 8in (15x20cm)

Tension

Tension is not important for this pattern

Instructions



Small Pumpkin

Pumpkin Body

Using a 6mm hook and chosen main body shade ch 11.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (10 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO along row to end. (10 st)

Repeat Row 2 until work measures 10 inches long, approx. 44 rows.

Fold work in half so ends meet. Slst ends together in BLO. Tie off.

Sew around the top edge of the work, through each row. Pull tight to gather and tie off.

Stuff work. Sew around open side of work to gather and close up.

Stalk

Using a 6mm hook and Big Value Chunky shade 'Moss' chain 6.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (5 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO in each st along row to end. (5 st)

Repeat 2nd Row 2 more times.

Fold in half so edges meet. Slst both edges together BLO. Tie off leaving 10-inch tail for sewing.

Sew stalk to top centre of pumpkin, stitching down to the bottom pucker of pumpkin and back to top several times to create a cinched effect.

Tie off and weave in tail.

Notes:

This pattern is written in UK terminology.

Medium Pumpkin

Pumpkin Body

Using a 6mm hook and chosen main body shade ch 21.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (20 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO along row to end. (20 st)

Repeat Row 2 until work measures 14 inches long, approx. 56 rows.

Fold work in half so ends meet. Slst ends together in BLO. Tie off.

Sew around the top edge of the work, through each row. Pull tight to gather and tie off.

Stuff work. Sew around open side of work to gather and close up.

Stalk

Using a 6mm hook and Big Value Chunky shade 'Moss' chain 8.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (7 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO in each st along row to end. (7 st)

Repeat 2nd Row 2 more times.

Fold in half so edges meet. Slst both edges together BLO. Tie off leaving 15-inch tail for sewing.

Sew stalk to top centre of pumpkin, stitching down to the bottom pucker of pumpkin and back to top several times to create a cinched effect.

Tie off and weave in tail.

Large Pumpkin

Pumpkin Body

Using a 6mm hook and chosen main body shade ch 31.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (30 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO along row to end. (30 st)

Repeat Row 2 until work measures 20 inches long, approx. 84 rows.

Fold work in half so ends meet. Slst ends together in BLO. Tie off.

Sew around the top edge of the work, through each row. Pull tight to gather and tie off.

Stuff work. Sew around open side of work to gather and close up.

Stalk

Using a 6mm hook and Big Value Chunky shade 'Moss' chain 10.

1st Row: Dc into 2nd ch from hook and along ch to end. (9 st)

2nd Row: Turn, ch 1 (does not count as st). Dc BLO in each st along row to end. (9 st)

Repeat 2nd Row 2 more times.

Fold in half so edges meet. Slst both edges together BLO. Tie off leaving 20-inch tail for sewing.

Sew stalk to top centre of pumpkin, stitching down to the bottom pucker of pumpkin and back to top several times to create a cinched effect.

Tie off and weave in tail.
